2011 flexible plan reimbursement claims go directly to Horace Mann. To check the balance of your account you can call 1-800-999-1030 option 4, then option 1 or you can go online to www.myflexonline.com.

Please remember that 2012 flexible plan claims now go to PayFlex. Both 2011 and 2012 reimbursement request forms are available online.

Was your medical claim denied?

If you have a claim that was denied, you will find the reason for the denial on the bottom of the explanation of benefits (eob) from NAA. The eob will either give a brief description of the denial or it will state the plan exclusion number that applies. You then refer to page 17 of your medical plan document (available online) to see a description of the exclusion.

You can get early access to your IMRF Annual Statement by going online and registering with IMRF. Simply go to www.imrf.org/myimrf to register. The Annual Statements will be available on February 23rd.

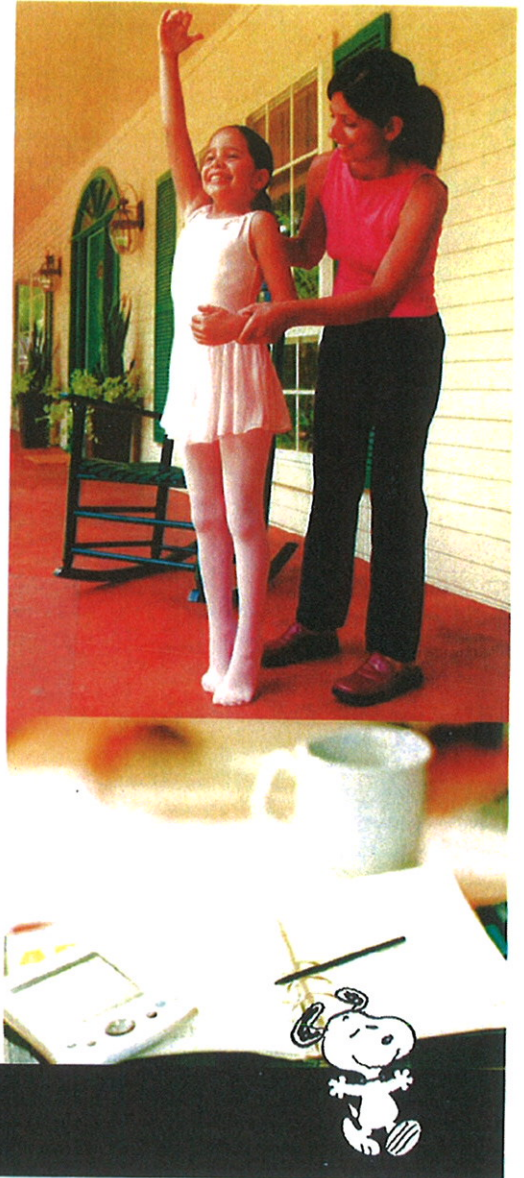
