Meeting Convened

The Board of Education of School District No. 172, Adams County, Illinois, met in regular session on May 17, 2023 at 6:00 p.m. in the Board of Education Office, Room 214, 1416 Maine Street, Quincy, Illinois, in said school district.

Roll Call

The meeting was called to order by President Arns, who directed the secretary to call the roll. Whereupon the President declared a quorum was present.

Arrival of Member Ali

Member Ali arrived at 6:01 p.m. which was duly noted by the Board Secretary.

Moment of Silence

President Arns declared a moment of silence and reflection.

Pledge of Allegiance

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by President Arns.

Questions and Comments

President Arns opened the meeting to questions and comments of members of the Board, by members of the public.

Dr. Todd Porter spoke on the topic of literacy and his concerns about balanced literacy and reading recovery. He shared materials with the Board in support of structured literacy.

2023-2024 District Improvement Plan

It was moved by Member Ali and seconded by Member Whitfield to approve the 2023-2024 District Improvement Plan (Doc. Reg. No. 3808). On the call of the roll, the following members voted Aye: Members Ali, Arns, Brock, Sethaler, and Whitfield; and the following members voted Nay: None; and the following members were absent: Member McNay and Member Petty. Whereupon the President declared the motion carried.

Building Committee

The Building Committee did not meet in May.

District Improvement Committee

The District Improvement Committee did not meet in May.

Finance Committee

The committee reviewed the monthly financial update, cash flow summary, and check registers. Chief of Business Operations, Ryan Whicker, shared information regarding the solicited fuel bids for the 2023-2024 school year. Bids were requested for both a "Firm Bid Price" and an "Escalating Bid Price". The district received two escalating bids and two firm bids. It was recommended that the district accept the low escalating bid from Energy Petroleum Company. Mr. Whicker also shared the recommendation from Jean Kinder, Food Services Director, to increase meal prices \$0.10. The recommended increase will bring the 2023-2024 lunch prices to \$2.85 for pre-K through fifth grade, \$3.10 for grades six through twelve, and \$3.60 for adults. Breakfast prices

were recommended to increase to \$1.50 for students and adult breakfast prices will remain at \$2.00. Mr. Whicker explained that the amended budget consists of very few significant changes. The O&M Fund saw an increase in expenditures due to the design and construction of the Central Services Facility. The Debt Service Fund saw increases in revenues and expenditures to account for the Bond Series 2014 refunding. The Transportation Fund saw increases in salary and benefits due to increased staffing. Other funds saw some changes between object levels in accounts but had an overall net zero effect on the budget.

Motor Fuel Bids

It was moved by Member Ali and seconded by Member Arns to approve the escalating bid for motor fuel as submitted by Energy Petroleum Company for a total estimated market price of \$242,386.50 (Doc. Reg. No. 3809). On the call of the roll, the following members voted Aye: Members Ali, Arns, Brock, Sethaler, and Whitfield; and the following members voted Nay: None; and the following members were absent: Member McNay and Member Petty. Whereupon the President declared the motion carried.

Increase Meal Prices

It was moved by Member Ali and seconded by Member Sethaler to approve increasing student lunch prices by ten cents. The 2023-2024 lunch prices will be \$2.85 for kindergarten through fifth grade and \$3.10 for grades six through twelve. The new adult meal price for 2023-2024 will be \$3.60. The 2023-2024 breakfast prices will be \$1.50 for all grades and adult breakfast prices will remain at \$2.00.
