Resumption of Rules

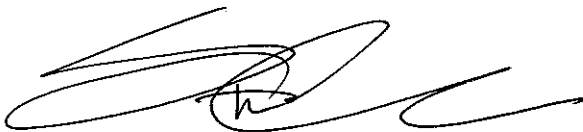
