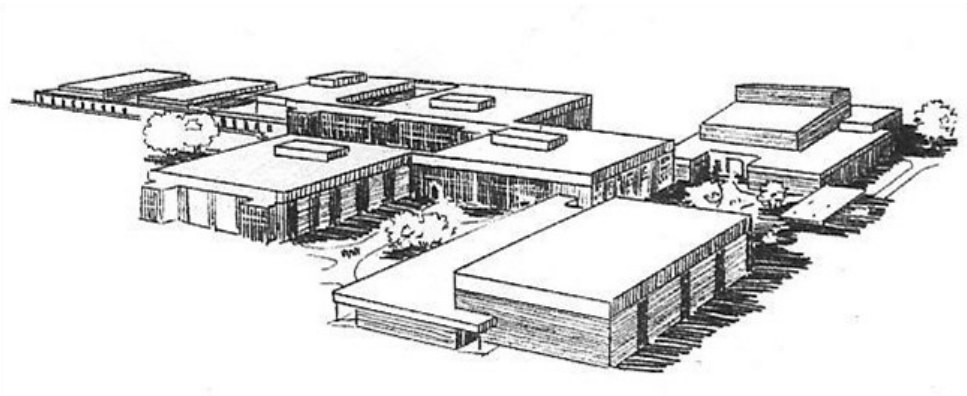

Each year more than 13,000 young men and women from high schools, colleges, junior colleges, the active Army and Army reserve units apply to the United States Military Academy for admission. The admissions staff reviews the academic records, tests the candidates medically and physically and then chooses those who have the potential to become future leaders of character for the Army and the nation. The result is a little over 1,200 applicants are offered admission.
