The student must be a graduating high school junior or senior who plans to pursue a higher education in the performing arts and/or music education after high school to qualify for this scholarship. We ask that all applications be received by **June 1st**. Scholarship funds will be awarded on the student's behalf to the university of their choosing upon confirmation of undergraduate enrollment. Deadlines for enrollment will be communicated with the scholarship recipient. Should confirmation not be completed, another candidate will be chosen.
