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Course Goals and Objectives

Each student in Mrs. Corriveau's class will be working independently on the Edgenuity courses decided upon with the Director or Assistant Director of the Academy. Students are expected to work on the course assigned for the specific block of the day. Teachers will not unlock assessments expected to be completed during other blocks. Each student's goal is to complete the courses they have been assigned by the end of the quarter.

Classroom management plan

Students are expected to work quietly and independently in the classroom. If students need help, the teacher may assist and explain during assignments and lessons.

Students are expected to act and speak appropriately and respectfully with their peers and teachers.

Edgenuity is the only program students are allowed to access while completing course work in class. Use of music playing services, or seeking answers from sources other than Edgenuity is not allowed.

Required course materials

Students should come prepared to class with their binder, a pen/pencil, headphones/earbuds. Guided notes, provided by the teacher, are strongly encouraged for all students. If a student chooses not to use guided notes, taking their own notes is another option.

Assessments and grading practices

Edgenuity tests must be taken in the classroom under teacher supervision. Teachers cannot give answers, or help complete test or quiz questions. If a student would like to retake a quiz or test, students may ask the teacher to review with them before their second attempt. Before a second attempt on a test, students must complete notes on the test topic. Guided notes are offered, and encouraged to be completed throughout the whole course.

Prior to tests being unlocked for students, the teacher will go through unit assignments to confirm they are completed thoroughly and meet the target outcomes. If the teacher finds that a student has typed a nonsense answer (eg: pushing random keys) or copied and pasted their response, the teacher will reset the assignment and the student will be required to redo the assignment before moving on.
