#### 2. Committee Discussion Items

# • Annual Report: 2023-2024 School Improvement Plans Review

Kim Dinkheller, Director of Curriculum, Instruction and Assessment, reviewed the school improvement plans developed by administrators and staff for each building. The plans incorporate the district's overall improvement goals tied to student success, effective instruction, learning environment and partnerships through performance measures and school level tasks. The plans will be posted on QPS website and will be reviewed quarterly at each school.

Kim noted that all 5 elementary schools will have or have had the opportunity to attend the Ron Clark Academy.

### • K-5 Report Card Update

Erica Maynard, Assistant Director of Curriculum, Instruction and Assessment provided an update on the K-5 Report Cards. Kindergarten piloted a new report card in the 2022-2023 school year which uses a four-point scale three times a year to measure student understanding in social and emotional development, foundational reading skills, reading, writing, language and math. Erica said the feedback received was all positive, there is less assessment and more instruction time. First and fourth grade will pilot a new report card during the 2023-2024 school year. The remaining grades, second, third and fifth will pilot new report cards during the 2024-2025 school year. All elementary grades will use trimester reporting beginning in the 2023-2024 school year. Teacher and parent guides for the new report cards will be made available.

# • 2023-2024 K-5 ELA and Math Curriculum Resource Pilot Update

Staff will pilot Reveal Math and Illustrative Math and Benchmark Workshop and Savvas MyView during the 2023-2024 school year. The teachers at all grade levels who have volunteered will receive training during August. All materials for the pilot will align with state standards and will follow curriculum maps with fidelity.

Pilot teachers will provide feedback and collaborate with grade level teams to share the information they have learned.
