ABC/ACRSS Edgenuity at Home

How do students get logged-in to online class(es)?

1-Student will need an active and working email/password for QPS account.



- 2- Log in to qps.org and then click on the CLEVER link symbol on the top of the page.
- 3- Click on Log in with Active Directory



- 4- Put in long form of student email and password for link to Clever District page
- 5- Scroll down the page to "Classroom Learning Tools" click on the link to arrive at website.
- 6- Student will first view an Orientation Video of navigating the online course and its features for self-monitoring calendar/grades/progress.
- 7- Click on the SUPPORT tab (upper right) on Edgenuity home page for Video Training Library this is full of tips for success and for learning further navigation abilities.

What are the expectations of the student for this online learning pathway?

1- Student will:

- a) be a self-starter who seeks independent navigation through high school.
- b) engage in the virtual instruction
- c) take e-notes/paper notes
- d) complete assignments as presented online
- e) successfully complete unlocked 10 question guiz.
- 2- Quizzes have a district set 70% threshold to permit pass to next lesson.
 - a) Student may automatically view result and retake if better grade is desired.
 - b) If student does not pass with the three allowed quiz attempts, teacher contact is necessary to proceed. (Email teacher immediately)
- 3- Topic Test Review assignment (which is averaged in the grade with NO threshold) must be completed to a satisfactory grade for student progression to the Unit/Topic

Test. When you email for an "unlock," your teacher <u>WILL BE</u> reviewing your work for understanding.

- 4- Unit/Topic Tests are Locked for Teacher Review
 - a) At this point, the student is reviewed by the teacher for concept understanding and success of unit work i.e. assigns, short responses, quizzes, test review assignment.
 - b) **IF** teacher review reveals quality work and understanding, then <u>Test is</u> unlocked.
 - c) **NOTE**: Student will be required to be **actively online** at the time of the test unlock as it will expire and re-lock within 10 minutes, if not started. (Email teacher for this test unlock)
 - d) TESTS will only be accessible between the school day hours of: 8:00 am to 3:30 pm.
 - e) ACRSS students will email Edgenuity Lab teacher at riggsc@qps.org from 8:00am until 12:15pm (1st-3rd blocks).
 - f) ABC students will email the following teachers at these times:
 - > 1st Block Mrs. Kelle (kellela@gps.org) 7:45-9:05
 - > 2nd Block Mr. Douglas (douglaje@qps.org) 9:07-10:22
 - > 5th Block Mr. McCarty (mccartde@qps.org) 12:17-1:30.
 - g) When the student becomes <u>LOCKED OUT</u> for teacher review, he/she needs to switch to work on another course and/or use the time for <u>unit and</u> quiz REVIEW to prepare for the TESTING session.

How much should students complete daily?

- 1- Students will be able to access a calendar within Edgenuity class that will designate the amount needed daily to finish by the target date. **Online Academy students are expected to be working 5 hours daily/25 hours weekly.**
- 2- Start date and End date will be specified to accurately track progress of course completion.
- 3- Other than times where the student and the teacher are communicating for TESTING, students are free to continue independently at any hour day or night.
- 4- When student has multiple online classes to complete, each day at home needs to model the timeline of a school day with juggling all needed work as specified in the course calendar on Edgenuity class(es)
- 5- Parents should familiarize themselves with their student's account to view the daily updates with their student to develop daily/weekly collaborated goals.

Who are the contact individuals who can help me navigate this process?

- 1. Contact assigned caseload teacher FIRST by email. Caseload assignment is below.
- 2. ACRSS students may also contact Edgenuity Lab teacher, Mr. Rigg (riggsc@gps.org) either through email or REMIND.
- 3. ABC students can contact their caseload teacher or their Edgenuity teacher that is on their schedule.
- 4. You will be expected to join the REMIND app for your caseload teacher. You can download the app and look for the teacher's class.
