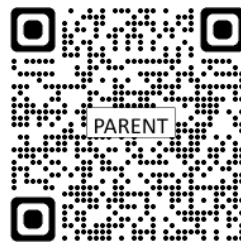

QHS SCHOOL WIDE TESTING

2nd Semester 2024

ISA:

The Illinois Science Assessment will be administered to all Juniors at QHS on Tuesday, March 19th. Classroom assignments will be posted around QHS and on the class Schoology page a week before the test. Students are required to report to their assigned classrooms by 7:25 am. The test will be conducted on a Chromebook, and no additional supplies are necessary. This test is mandatory for all Juniors.

SAT/PSAT:

QHS will conduct the SAT on Tuesday, April 9th, exclusively for Juniors, and the PSAT on Wednesday, April 10th, exclusively for Sophomores and Freshmen. Classroom assignments for students will be posted around QHS and on the student's class Schoology page the week prior to the test. Students must be present in their assigned classrooms by 7:25 am. Students will only participate in the testing day relevant to their grade level. Following the completion of the test, students are permitted to leave, and no regular classes will be held on the testing day. Buses will operate on their normal schedule. Students with accommodations may be required to attend testing on multiple days, and they will be notified accordingly.

SAT/PSAT testing is mandatory for all students in the State of Illinois. Seniors who did not take the mandatory SAT test last year must participate in the SAT on April 9th. Successful completion of the SAT test is a graduation requirement for all students. Seniors who have already taken the SAT will have a College/Career Day (independently) on both April 9th and 10th and are not required to attend school on these days. Normal school operations will resume on April 11th.
