

SUMMER SCHOOL PROGRAMS

21st CCLC Program

Summer school for high school students will commence on Monday, June 3. Students needing to recover more than two credits will participate in the 21st CCLC program. School counselors will be contacting parents regarding sign-up. Transportation is available, but pre-registration is required.

For this program, students are mandated to attend daily from 7:45 a.m. to 11:45 a.m. Lunch will be provided in the cafeteria for all students from 11:45 a.m. to 12:10 p.m. Students utilizing school transportation will remain for lunch. Those with their own transportation are free to leave at 11:45 a.m.

Upon arrival in the classroom, students will have their phones collected. Phones will be securely held in a cabinet for the duration of the day and returned prior to dismissal. Traditional Summer School

Summer school for high school students will begin on Monday, June 3rd and conclude on June 28th.

Students needing to recover a course or work ahead in earning credits will participate in the traditional summer school program and a link will be sent out for students to preregister.

For the Traditional summer school program, students are mandated to attend on June 3rd for an introduction and ensuring they can access the Edgenuity program. Students will be able to complete homework and assignments at home, but testing is required in person. Teachers will be available Monday-Friday from 7:45 a.m. to 11:45 a.m. for students to test or come in and work on their coursework.

Drivers Education Classroom will be offered Monday, June 3rd – July 3rd from 8:00 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. Students will not be allowed to miss more than two days or they will be dropped from the course.
