1. **VALENTINE'S DAY GIFT DELIVERIES:** Please be aware that Quincy Junior High School will not be accepting any flowers, balloons, or gift deliveries for students for Valentine's Day. Unfortunately, these deliveries can be overwhelming for our office staff, with nearly 1400 students potentially receiving gifts. Deliveries, although fun to get, can be disruptive to the school by tying up staff time and distracting students from their lessons. Also, balloon bouquets are not allowed onto buses because they obstruct the driver's vision. We apologize if this disrupts your plans; please help us preserve an environment that will be conducive to all students' learning. Thank you!

2. **COMET CHOIR** will rehearse after school until 3:40 p.m. on Tuesdays. This choir is open to anyone who would like to sing! Any student interested in joining should see Mrs. Scholz in the music room, located in room 232.
3. **LOST AND FOUND:** If you have lost something, please check the lost and found in the Main Office before or after school. Articles not claimed by the end of the month will be donated or discarded. Also, please check with your P.E. teacher for items lost in the physical education area, and in the cafeteria office for items lost in the cafeteria.
4. **LIBRARY:** The library is open daily for any student to work on homework and use the library computers and other resources. Monday through Friday, students may go to the library at 7:25 a.m. until time to report to first hour, then again after school until 3:30 p.m.
5. **LUNCH MONEY DEPOSIT PROCEDURE FOR STUDENTS:** Before 7:45 a.m., take your lunch deposits to the Main Office and deposit them in the Lunch Deposit Box. Deposits made after 7:45 a.m. will not be posted until the next school day.
6. **ATTENTION STUDENTS:** Please do not use the auditorium as a hallway when going to classes. You need to go around the auditorium.
7. **RESTROOMS:** Students are not to use the restrooms in the foyer of the auditorium. These restrooms are for staff use only.
8. **STUDENTS WHO HAVE TO CROSS BROADWAY BEFORE OR AFTER SCHOOL:** Students who live north of Broadway do not have to walk across Broadway. They can meet Bus #59 at 14th & Spring at 7:20 a.m. to come to school. After school, students can meet Bus #5 in the bus line-up on 14th Street. The afternoon bus will drop off on 12th and Spring. Students who cross Broadway, on a daily basis, going to and from school, are encouraged to participate in this safety program.
9. **ATHLETIC SHUTTLE BUS:** Student athletes who need to ride the shuttle bus to Senior High or Flinn each day will take Bus #55 in the second line-up on 14th Street.
