## Quincy Junior High School: STRENGTHS

- QJHS continues to embrace the middle school model looking carefully at the development of the whole child. We continue
  to offer opportunities for students to explore their interests through quarterly electives, music, athletics, foreign language,
  student leadership, and clubs.
- Staff Collaboration (Teaming and PLC) along with our Multi-Tiered Systems of Support and Advisory time has helped teachers and support staff identify students who need academic, behavioral or social-emotional support, allowing them to partner with parents to support student success.
- Data is used to drive our programming and procedures. If the data does not support either, then we adapt, change, or eliminate.
- Job-embedded professional development continues to be an integral part of what we do. Backward Design and the implementation of co-teaching at all grade levels continue to be at the forefront of our professional learning.
- QJHS was above National Norms on the Spring NWEA MAP Assessment in 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> grade Science and 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> grade Language Usage.

- QJHS will continue to increase student achievement and student growth with all students placing emphasis on our targeted subgroups: children with disabilities, black students, and Hispanic students.

#### SCHOOL TASKS AND STAFF PD TO SUPPORT GOAL

- All grade level teams will utilize RtI Team Time to monitor students academically and recommend for additional support or intervention through the MTSS process.
- Core subject area teachers will create instructional tasks and student activities aligned to learning targets for their subject area with particular attention to Depth of Knowledge (DOK) levels.
- Grade level PLCs will align common assessments to DOK levels to ensure students receive aligned feedback.
- Core subject area teachers will begin to differentiate lessons, tasks, and assessments based on student need.
