Complete applications are to be submitted by the end of the QAVTC school day no later than Friday, March 27th, 2026.

Scholarship

The scholarship committee will be awarding 2 annual scholarship awards from eligible applicants with completed applications. The amount awarded will be a minimum amount of \$500 each. Eligibility requirements are as follows:

- A. Applicants must be current students in good standing at Quincy Area Vocational Technical Center with a minimum of one academic year of participation.
- B. Applicants must be students graduating from an area high school that is eligible to be served by QAVTC.
- C. Applicants must have successfully completed a vocational – technical program or professional prep course offered by QAVTC.

The Scholarship Committee will utilize the applications and in person interviews (if necessary) of the top applicants to determine the scholarship award recipients.

- A. Qualified applicants will be placed in 2 categories consisting of an “academic” (4 year college) and a “trade” (2 year college, community college, tech/trade school) groupings based on their choice for continuing their training and or education.
- B. Applicants are then judged against others within the same grouping based on the following criteria:
 1. Academic ability. (Grades, grades in specialized courses)
 2. Character. (citizenship, community and school involvement)
 3. Attitude. (work ethic, school attendance, school behavior)
 4. Interview performance. (communication ability, personal presentation)
 5. Financial need. (financial aid, family resources, savings)

Applicants must submit a copy of a letter of acceptance or application to attend a qualified accredited college, community college, vocational or technical or trade school. The 4 year college major must be within the scope of a recognized vocational or technical area of study requiring a bachelor’s degree.

Payment of scholarship amount awarded will be made directly to the educational or training institution by the scholarship committee upon receiving acceptable enrollment notification.

- A. Students must be enrolled at the college or institution or training program listed in the scholarship application. The awarded scholarship must be claimed by June 1st of the calendar year in which the scholarship was awarded to avoid risk of losing scholarship.
- B. The scholarship committee must be contacted no later than September 15th if the student is not enrolling for the fall semester in the year in which the scholarship is awarded.

OFFICIAL APPLICATION

This is a scholarship made available to current senior vocational students at the Quincy Area Vocational Technical Center. In order for the application to be considered complete it must be filled out in its entirety and meet all criteria listed previously in this packet.
