QHS Parking Lot Sticker Sales

NOTE: Stickers will be sold in the following time slots on August 7, 2023:

8:00 a.m. – 10:00 a.m. – Seniors with 22 or more credits.

10:00 a.m. to Noon – Seniors with 20 or more credits

Noon to 2:00 p.m. – ANY Senior

August 8, 2023: 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. – ANY Senior

Seniors can find their credit count under the "Scheduling > GPA" tab in their Skyward accounts.

Please have the enclosed registration form filled out when you purchase your Quincy High School parking lot sticker for \$60. Remember, just because you have the form filled out, you must wait until your level of credits is being sold. **REMINDER – Stickers are designated for Upper, Main and Lower Lots and are NOT assigned to specific parking spots.**

Stickers will be sold in credit increments to Seniors in the QHS "A" Building lobby (in front of the auditorium) beginning Monday, August 7th, for \$60 using the above listed schedule. Seniors ONLY will be able to purchase stickers prior to school starting. Announcements will be made if space is available for juniors once school begins. Stickers will be sold to juniors using the following priorities: Juniors that have signed the Waiting List in the Main Office and then by number of credits earned through 2023-24. Flinn Lot stickers will not be sold this year.

At some point the number of students with the eligible number of credits MAY exceed the number of spots available. At that time, stickers will be sold on a first-come basis to Seniors with the eligible number of credits. Seniors may only purchase stickers for their personal vehicle or family vehicle. Stickers <u>MAY NOT</u> be purchased for a friend's vehicle. <u>Stickers are non-transferable.</u> Display your parking decal in the lower right <u>BACK</u> window (outside on window—passenger's side – <u>not the window on the side of the car</u>).

Don't forget to have your QHS Parking Registration Form filled out. You will also need to **SHOW a valid Illinois Driver's License and SHOW Proof of Insurance** (must be current) when you get your sticker). Also, don't forget your \$60 for your sticker. If paying by check, make the check payable to Quincy High School.

After all the QHS parking stickers are sold, seniors may be placed on a waiting list by filling out a QHS Parking Waiting List Form available in the QHS Main Office. (Spaces may not become available until 2nd semester.)

Quincy High School Parking Rules

Driving your car to school is a privilege. To maintain this privilege, certain rules concerning the schools' parking lots must be observed. The safety of people and property is always of utmost importance.

- 1. Display your parking permit in the **REAR** window on the passenger side (outside on **REAR** window—passenger's side). Students are not allowed to back into parking spots.
- 2. Do not loiter in cars on the parking lot.
- 3. YELLOW curbs are NO PARKING AREAS.
- 4. BLUE curbs are for STAFF PARKING ONLY.
- WHITE curbs are for VISTORS.
- 6. Signs mark other restricted parking places.
- 7. If no spots are available in your designated lot, park in the staff area nearest the north side (Maine Street) and notify front door security.
- 8. Parking around the Vocational Center is for staff and county students only.
- 9. Cruising through the parking lot is not permitted.
- 10. Student parking is not allowed at the Tangerine Bowl or YMCA (unless you have purchased a spot from them), or on any of the neighboring private parking lots (former ShopKo, Showcase Theatre, Mercantile, etc.) The local business will address any issues with unauthorized parking and QHS is not responsible for those actions.
- 11. Report all thefts and accidents immediately to security or the deans' office.
- 12. The school district is not responsible for theft, vandalism, or damage to student's vehicles while they are parked on Quincy High School lots.
- 13. Sophomores are not allowed to park on the Quincy High School lot. Juniors are not allowed to park on the QHS lots unless there are openings and the student has been contacted by QHS staff to determine interest and then the junior student is properly registered to park in a QHS lot.
- 14. School officials have the right to search, given reasonable cause, vehicles parked on school property/parking lots.
- 15. Violation of the parking rules will result in disciplinary action, including suspensions, city tickets, or loss of parking privileges. Vehicles, which continue to be parked illegally, will be towed.
- 16. Students should make note of and follow all signage (ie, DO Not Enter, Staff Only, etc.)
- 17. Parking registrations are non-transferable. This includes siblings, early graduates, students not present at school or anything else.
- 18. Students who have early dismissal due to an extracurricular activity may not park on the QHS lots all day. However, after they are dismissed for the day, they may get their car and then park in the QHS Student Parking Area. This is usually in the afternoon and spots for all authorized students should be available. If on an overnight trip during the school week, contact the Main Office for directions.
