<p>Literacy Activity: Practice spelling your first name out loud. Find something in your house that starts with each letter.</p> <p>Math /Gym Activity: Practice counting from 1-25 by doing: *25 Jumping Jacks *25 Sit Ups *25 Toe Touches *25 Push Ups *Rest in resting pose while you count to 25.</p> <p>Science: Look out your window and notice how spring is coming. Do you see buds on the trees? Do you see grass and flowers growing? Do you hear birds singing? Tell your family what you see and hear during springtime.</p>	<p>Literacy/Music Activity: Sing the ABCs out loud with your family. Find either a magazine, book, letter, piece of mail, etc. Look for letters of the alphabet that you know. Finger circle ones that you find. Try finding a letter or 2 you don't know yet with your family.</p> <p>Math Activity: Find things in your house that are squares and rectangles. Take pictures of these things with your family or draw pictures on a piece of paper. Have your family use your pictures to quiz you on which is which!</p> <p>Fine Motor: Find clothing items with zippers in your house. Practice zipping all by yourself!</p>	<p>Literacy Activity: Use the attached rhyming activity to find things in your house that rhyme! Try to write the sounds you hear for that word with help from your family.</p> <p>Math/Gym Activity: Make an AB pattern by using your body (stomp jump stomp jump) or (spin sit spin sit) Make an ABC pattern with your body (jump sit stand jump sit stand) Think of other patterns you could do to move your body.</p> <p>Science/Art/Fine Motor: Think about the different weather that can happen during the spring. Divide a piece of paper in four sections. Draw a different type of weather in each section of the paper (rainy, sunny, windy, etc)</p>	<p>Literacy Activity: Say the first sound of ball (b): Find things in your house that start with the same sound. Do the same for things that start like cat (c), lamp (l), sun (s), and table (t).</p> <p>Math/Motor Activity: Help your family clean! Grab a wet towel and scrub your table, counters, shower etc. Push really hard in a circular motion to build strength. While you do this, count to 25 on each surface you are cleaning!</p> <p>Science/Math: Find different items in your house that fit into 3 groups: Hard/Soft/Hard and Soft. Count the items in each group. Which group had the most? Which had the least? Were any groups equal?</p>	<p>Literacy Activity: Have an adult help you write the names of everyone in your family. Be sure each name starts with a capital letter. Count the number of letters in each name. Whose name is the shortest? Longest? Are any the same length? Do any of your names share the same letters?</p> <p>Math Activity: Find things in your house that are circles and triangles. Take pictures of these things with your family or draw pictures on a piece of paper. Have your family use your pictures to quiz you on which is which!</p> <p>Fun Friday Activity: Turn on music and dance together! Make up a dance and teach it to your family.</p>

<p style="text-align: center;">Monday March 30</p> <p>Literacy Activity: Write your first name 5 times. Use different colors and rainbow write over the top. Say each letter as you write it. Maybe you could do your last name today too!</p> <p>Math /Gym Activity: Practice counting from 1-25 by doing: *25 Jumping Jacks *25 Sit Ups *25 Toe Touches *25 Push Ups *Rest in resting pose while you count to 25.</p> <p>Science/Music: Have an adult fill some glasses or jars with water. Fill them all with different amounts. Tap each jar with a spoon and notice how the pitches change. Empty a bit out of a jar. Did it change? Can you use your jars to make a song by changing the amounts?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Tuesday March 31</p> <p>Math/Literacy/Art: Talk with your family about what you would do to your room to make it your "Dream Room." What color would it be? What furniture would you have? What kinds of pictures would be on the walls? Draw a picture of your dream room. Include something in your picture that is a circle, square, rectangle, and triangle. Label these items by sound-stretching (writing the sounds you hear) next to those four things!</p> <p>Gym Activity: See the attached yoga animal poses! Go on an animal walk in your living room. Make up an animal pose and teach it to your family.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Wednesday April 1</p> <p>Literacy/Music Activity: Sing A Hunting We Will Go with your family "A hunting we will go, a hunting we will go. We'll catch a (animal name) and put him in a (object) and then we'll let him go." You know this from music! (goat/boat snake/cake fox/box whale/pail mouse/house cat/hat)</p> <p>Math Activity: Play Blast off! Crouch near the ground and count backwards from 5-1. Jump up to say BLASTOFF at the end. Repeat until you can count from 5 to 1 on your own!</p> <p>Fine Motor: Practice writing the numbers 1-5 on a piece of paper. Then write them backwards from 5-1.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Thursday April 2</p> <p>Literacy Activity: Say the first sound of dog (d): Find things in your house that start with the same sound. Do the same for things that start like fish (f), monkey (m), rug (r) and van (v).</p> <p>Math/Motor Activity: Help your family clean! Grab a wet towel and scrub your table, counters, shower etc. Push really hard in a circular motion to build strength. While you do this, count to 25 on each surface you are cleaning!</p> <p>Science/Math: Find different items in your house that fit into 3 groups: Large/Mediu/Small Count the items in each group. Which group had the most? Which had the least? Were any groups equal?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Friday April 3</p> <p>Literacy Activity: Find five food products in your kitchen. Find the word that labels that item. (A can of peaches says Peaches.) Copy those words on a piece of paper.</p> <p>Math Activity: Find 5 of the same items (rocks, stickers, blocks, etc). Then find 6 of something else. Do the same with the number 7, 8, 9, and 10.</p> <p>Fun Friday Activity: Make up a story about someone in your family. Think of a place they are at and think of something silly that happens to them. Tell that person your silly story. Then have your family make up a silly story about you!</p>

Think of something that rhymes with the following pictures! Write the sounds of the word that rhymes.



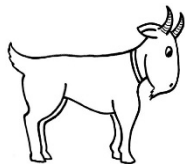
