2. **GLOW DANCE:** The QJHS dance, "Neon Northern Lights" will be held on Wednesday, December 14<sup>th</sup>, in the upper gym. 10. **LUNCH MONEY DEPOSIT PROCEDURE FOR STUDENTS:** Before 7:45 a.m., take your lunch deposits to the Main Office and deposit them in the Lunch Deposit Box. Deposits made after 7:45 a.m. will not be posted until the next school day.
11. **RESTROOMS:** Students are not to use the restrooms in the foyer of the auditorium. These restrooms are for staff use only.
12. **STUDENTS WHO HAVE TO CROSS BROADWAY BEFORE OR AFTER SCHOOL:** Students who live north of Broadway do not have to walk across Broadway. They can meet Bus #5 at 14<sup>th</sup> & Spring at 7:20 a.m. to come to school. After school, students can meet Bus #5 in the bus line-up on 14<sup>th</sup> street.
