1. **NO SCHOOL:** There will be no school on Monday, October 11, in observance of Columbus Day.
2. **PICTURE MAKEUP/RETAKE DAY** is scheduled for Thursday, October 13, from 7:45 a.m. to 2:15 p.m. in room 340. Staff and students, who were not here for fall picture day in August, should have their picture taken on October 13, during P.E. or Health class. Students need to report to their teacher first before going to room 340. This is the last opportunity to have a photo included in the yearbook. If you ordered a picture package during our first picture day and want another photo taken, students **MUST** bring back the photo package for replacement. Parents who did not order a photo package, and would like another photo to be taken, may have their student/s picture taken on October 13. 3. **7/8 BOYS' BASKETBALL:** Tryouts are scheduled for Monday, October 17, Tuesday, October 18, and Wednesday, October 19. Practices are scheduled to take place at BALDWIN ELEMENTARY (BLUE DEVIL GYM). 7<sup>th</sup> graders will try out from 6:15-8:15 p.m. all three days and 8<sup>th</sup> graders will try out from 4:45-6:45 p.m. all three days. A parent-player meeting will take place on Thursday, October 20, at 6:00 p.m. in the BALDWIN cafeteria. Please log into Skyward to fill out the required athletic forms. These forms are due by Monday, October 10.
4. **7/8 CHEER:** Tryout practices will be held in the QJHS lower gym on Tuesday, October 18, and Wednesday, October 19, from 3:00-4:30. Tryouts will be in the QJHS lower gym on Thursday, October 20, from 3:00-5:00. It is **REQUIRED** that those trying out attend **ALL 3 DAYS**. Parents, please log in to Skyward and fill out the required paper before tryouts. All paperwork is due on Monday, October 17.
5. **QJHS CHORAL CONCERT:** Everyone is invited to attend the Quincy Junior High School Choral Concert on Tuesday, October 18, at 7:00 p.m. in the Auditorium. Admission is \$2.00 per person and \$10 for families of 5 or more. Hope to see you there!

7. **AFTER-SCHOOL INSTRUMENTAL CHOIR** will meet on Tuesday, October 11, from 2:45-3:45 in room 232. Please have your ride pick you up promptly at 3:45 in the Morrison Theatre Parking Lot.
8. **OCTOBERFEST:** Everyone is invited to enjoy the 26<sup>th</sup> Annual Octoberfest Parade and Field Competition, featuring 20 marching bands from Illinois, Missouri, and Iowa, on Saturday, October 15. The parade will begin at 2:00 p.m. at Senior High and travel west to Junior High. The field competition begins at 5:00 p.m. at Flinn Stadium. The Symphonic Band, Color Guard, and Pommers will perform this year in the parade and the opening ceremonies of the field competition. Hope to see everyone there!
9. **LUNCH MONEY DEPOSIT PROCEDURE FOR STUDENTS:** Before 7:45 a.m., take your lunch deposits to the Main Office and deposit them in the Lunch Deposit Box. Deposits made after 7:45 a.m. will not be posted until the next school day.

11. **STUDENTS WHO HAVE TO CROSS BROADWAY BEFORE OR AFTER SCHOOL:** Students who live north of Broadway do not have to walk across Broadway. They can meet Bus #5 at 14<sup>th</sup> & Spring at 7:20 a.m. to come to school. After school, students can meet Bus #5 in the bus line-up on 14<sup>th</sup> street. Students who cross Broadway, on a daily basis, going to and from school, are encouraged to participate in this safety program.
