FROM SUPERINTENDENT WEBB—BOARD MEETING REVIEW

The search to fill three key positions—Rooney principal, Academy director, and K-12 music director, is on track with the goal of bringing the recommendations to the Board by the April board meeting.

The Board approved the contingency contract to purchase real estate at 1600 N. 43rd. The school district has been looking at the possibility of consolidating transportation facilities and possibly house maintenance facilities in the same location. To finance this purchase, plans call for using \$1.6 million earmarked for capital projects, including proceeds from the sale of old schools, the sale of items from the old schools and rebates tied to school construction projects, toward the purchase along with money in the transportation, operations, and maintenance funds.

The District Improvement Committee recommended a new math course, *Pre-Algebra* which was approved by the Board. The course is for students in 7th or 8th grade math who struggle in Algebra 1. The course will count as a math credit rather than as an elective.

The last day for students will be June 2, with June 3 the last day for teachers. The Amended Calendar and last day will be approved at the April board meeting.
