Superintendent Reflection Year One

- My first year allowed me to determine district systems functioned and have shaped my focus for 23/24. We will not only focus on those things that give us challenges but also systems that are working, answering the question "how do we become better," continuing to be innovative and always striving for excellence.
- QPS continues to be a resource for not only area districts but districts across the state because we have the reputation of being ahead of the curve and innovative.
- 42 Teacher Residents since 2018/2019 SY. 15 of those have obtained their professional educator licensure. Those are 42 positions that would go unfilled.
- ♦ 316 School/Classroom Visits
- Attendance, Behavior and Emotional Healthcare needs of students are on the rise. We have many supports and partnerships in place to address the needs such as Thriving Minds, Bella Ease, Community Healthcare Workers, our own social workers, social emotional school administrative managers, counselors and deans.
- QHS Increased graduation success 8% over last year. This will continue to be a district focus as it takes all of us to take a child from PreK graduating from QHS.
- Blue Devil Fridays increased momentum and garnered community and business support.
- QPS Foundation Raised \$564,457 this year. We are so fortunate to have the support of the Foundation along with so many other corporations and area Foundations.
