FROM SUPERINTENDENT WEBB—BOARD MEETING REVIEW

At the July 25th meeting, the Board of Education appointed Shelley Arns to the Board vacancy created by the resignation of Sandi Rose. Shelley is a former teacher in the district and has served as a volunteer in many areas including the district Discipline Committee, PTA, Superintendent Search Committee, Dream Big Committee and the building campaign. President Ali said she is a well-respected community member who is familiar with Quincy and the school district. He said a board member of her quality is a big win for the district and School Board. Shelley will also chair the Discipline Committee and serve as co-chair on the Curriculum Committee. Shelley said she has remained consistent in her efforts to bring her best to Quincy Public Schools as a student, educator and volunteer and she is eager to do that work as a school board member.

The Board hired Jason Wallingford, Trophy Properties, to conduct the auction of Dewey and Washington School buildings, the lots behind Dewey, and surplus items. The auction will be held on line for 30 days beginning August 22. An inspection day will be scheduled during that time to allow potential bidders to tour the property. The sale will be marketed locally and nationwide through the internet and social media.

District support staff, teachers and principals have done an amazing job with moving and preparing for the opening of the K-5 schools. Many teachers and principals have spent their summer hours working in the buildings getting ready for the new year. I want to recognize just a few of the heroes. Special thanks to Carol Frericks and her team for developing the transition plan which is in full execution mode. Dane Barnes, Maintenance Director, and his team of custodians and maintenance staff, have done a yeoman's job and are ahead of schedule moving teachers' boxes and furniture. Dan Ware, Information Technology Coordinator, has been extremely tenacious with Comcast to get internet service up and running at the new schools. Construction Supervisor Dave Wombles is overseeing all the school construction projects and works tirelessly watching over the details. Special gratitude to Board Member Richard McNay for providing trucking service for delivery of the new furniture. Thanks to everyone for their hard work as we look forward to an exciting year with our K-5 schools.

Dedication ceremonies are planned for Colonel George J. Iles Elementary and Dr. Abby Fox Rooney Elementary Schools. All staff are invited. The dedication of Iles Elementary, 3111 N. 12th St, will be held Saturday, August 4 at 10:30 a.m. Rooney, 4900 Columbus Rd, will hold its dedication on Saturday, August 11 at 10:30 a.m. Special thanks to Board Member Carol Nichols and Public Information Officer Raquel Piazza for their work on planning these ceremonies, inviting special guests, and publicizing the events.
