FROM SUPERINTENDENT PETTIT BOARD MEETING REVIEW

Fall athletics and extracurricular activities are in full swing and things are going very well around the district as I go in and out of schools and events. The homecoming parade was well attended by students from elementary through high school. Many community members came out to support the parade and rally with a nearly standing room only football game win. Special thanks to the high school administrative staff along with Greg Wellman and Stacie Niffen for their hard work in making this event so successful.

Cyndi Ott, school nurse at Early Childhood and Family Center, was presented with a certificate for being one of three finalists for Illinois School Nurse of the Year. The Illinois Association of School Nurses presents the award each year to an exemplary member to recognize work to help students be healthy, safe, and ready to learn. Mrs. Ott was also presented with the Spirit and Pride award to honor her 25 years of selfless service to our district.

The Board approved the 2022-2023 District Budget. Mr. Whicker explained that the only material change to the budget was attributed to Health Insurance. The budget includes increases in Local Property Taxes, EBF, Corporate Property Replacement Taxes, and a large increase in Federal funding due to ESSER II/III. The budget also incorporates a 4% increase in salaries, except for Paraeducators, Transportation, Food Service, and Security departments, which received a higher increase. Overall, the 2022-23 District Budget is a \$96.1M balanced budget.
